PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES FOR
NOVEMBER 19, 2009

Approval of Minutes:

David Gilbey made a motion to approve the June 18, 2009 meeting minutes. Chad Gooch seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Introduction of Comprehensive Plan Goals/ Policies Review:

Jim Jacks gave a brief overview of the Staff Report.

The Planning Commission discussed the issues with the availability of water for the City of Lafayette and needing a 20-year land supply. They discussed options for possible remedies for the water situation and what information may be obtained from the Water Master Plan. Lori Labb noted that she would get copies of the Water Master Plan for the Commissioners.

Marian Chasse made a motion to address issues in terms of goals being current and up to date. Actions need to be taken care of in order by priority that is determined by the Planning Commission. Motion died due to lack of a second.

Dwayne Brittell noted that he had read the whole Comprehensive Plan and he thought it was pretty good. Not a lot of work deeded on the Plan (policies and goals. Let's see what the citizens want.

David Gilbey noted that before the comprehensive plan is reviewed they should determine what the opinion of the citizens are. The label for the questionnaire should be Community Vision, rather than just a questionnaire or survey. Look 20-years down the road. Solve problems. What do the citizens want the city to be in 20-years.

Todd Holt noted that there was a need to plan and provide 20-year land supply.

There was agreement between the Commissioners that there should be a questionnaire.

Discussion on the questionnaire would continue at the January Meeting.
