## *New Fire Station Progress*

The City is making great progress on the new Fire Station building, located at 375 Market Street. The contractor, Haworth, Inc. from McMinnville, is currently working on the foundation and installing the below-slab plumbing, wiring, and other utilities.

Over the next few months, the walls will be constructed and the structure will start to take shape. The Lafayette Fire Station is scheduled to open on-time in the summer of 2020.

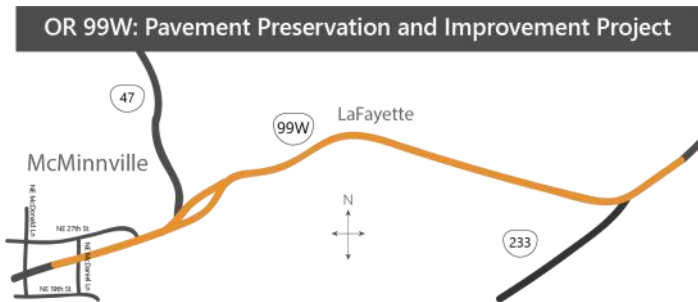

## OR 99W Paving Project Set for 2021

ODOT has scheduled right-of-way work in Lafayette for the summer of 2021. The rock base of the road will be rebuilt along with several street corners and sidewalks to meet new accessibility standards. While currently in the design phase, the construction contract will be bid in August 2020 and a project schedule determined by spring of 2021.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained for all Third Street businesses during the construction timeframe. ## Time to Conserve Water

Customer sewer rates are determined by using your average water consumption during winter months. November through February is the time to conserve water to keep your sewer rate as low as possible for the coming year. Water consumption averages are calculated in March and you will see your recalculated sewer rate on your April 1, 2020 bill.
