**Approving a rate schedule for Recology Western)
Oregon, effective July 1, 2015)**

Resolution No. 2015-04

THE CITY COUNCIL (the "Council") OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON (the "City") sat for the transaction of City business on Thursday, June 11, 2015 in the Council Chambers at City hall.

WHEREAS, at the December 8, 2005 meeting, the Council adopted Ordinance 579, to become effective January 7, 2006, amending, in its entirety, the original exclusive franchise for the collection and disposal of solid waste in the City which was granted by Ordinance No. 398, to City Sanitary & Recycling Service, DBA Western Oregon Waste, (now DBA Recology Western Oregon) McMinnville, Oregon ("Franchisee"); and

WHEREAS, the franchise agreement establishes a procedure for setting, by separate resolution, the rates that Franchisee may charge in the City; and

WHEREAS, the franchise agreement establishes an Operating Ratio Range which, if financial data indicates is not being met, allows franchisee to request rates that will bring them back within the range, or it may instead apply an annual cost of living adjustment to the rates based upon the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for the 'West B/C' during the past year; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2015, Franchisee submitted a rate increase request of 0.90% based on CPI-U for the 'West B/C.'


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lafayette, Oregon that:

1. As authorized by Ordinance No. 579, and to be effective July 1, 2015, Franchisee's rates shall be adjusted by 0.90%, and the approved rate schedule shall be adopted as set forth in the rate sheet attached as "Exhibit A," which by this reference is made a part hereof as if set forth at length herein.
2. This Resolution is effective immediately.

Please find attached to this letter the following items:

As we presented in our rate application submitted April 1st, 2015, rates for most services will be adjusted by the contractual CPI adjustment of 0.90% to be effective July 1st, 2015.

You will note that some rates have not changed, including the rates for medical waste services. Also, debris box disposal rates were increased to reflect changes in the rates charged to us by Riverbend Landfill (also happens to be 0.90% this year).

Based on our previous conversation, we will plan to attend the June 11th Council meeting. Please let me know if you have any questions or service issues you want addressed at that time.
