**DECLARATION OF FIRE ENGINE No. 2            )**  
**AS SURPLUS PROPERTY                            )**           **RESOLUTION NO. 2015-11**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON sat for the transaction of City business on Thursday, July 9, 2015, at 6:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

**WHEREAS**, with the recent purchase of a new primary engine, the City has no need for two backup engines; and

**WHEREAS**, the oldest backup engine is a 1990 Western States/Ford model, it has been fully depreciated over 25 years, and it no longer has value to the City as a Lafayette Fire Department apparatus; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lafayette City Council must determine the disposition of any property with a value greater than \$500, and the estimated value of the 1990 Fire Engine is approximately \$10,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council for the City of Lafayette hereby approves the following:

1. The 1990 Western States/Ford model Fire Engine is declared surplus property;
2. The City Administrator is authorized to advertise and sell the engine to other interested parties; and
3. A smaller Fire District or Department may procure the engine on terms to be approved by Council.

This Resolution shall be effective upon passage by the Council.
