A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2020-02, DECLARING A STATE OF EMERGENCY IN THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE CAUSED BY THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, The Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic has impacted the world and our President, Governor, and Yamhill County Commissioners declared an emergency; and

WHEREAS, Lafayette residents, business owners, and visitors were at-risk of contracting the disease; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lafayette under the authority granted by ORS Chapter 401 and Chapter 2.7 of the Lafayette Municipal Code declared a state of emergency on March 26, 2020 and enacted policies to protect the health, safety, and property of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the threat to essential public services provided by the City of Lafayette has subsided; and,

WHEREAS, Governor Brown rescinded the State of Oregon's Declaration of Emergency as of June 30, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAFAYETTE CITY COUNCIL that Resolution 2020-02, Declaring A State Of Emergency In The City Of Lafayette Caused By The Coronavirus (Covid-19) Pandemic, is hereby rescinded and the State of Emergency terminated for the City of Lafayette.

This Resolution shall be and is effective from and after its passage by the Council.
