**In the Matter of the Sale of
Surplus Property**

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RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01

THE CITY COUNCIL (the "Council") OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON (the "City") sat for the transaction of City business on March 14, 2024, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall and considered and approved the following Resolution.

WHEREAS, Lafayette Resolution 2024-01 provides for the disposal of surplus property and defines surplus property as "any personal property of the City that has been determined to be of no use or value to the City"; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator submitted a request to the Council for a declaration that the property described on Exhibit A, attached hereto, is of no further use or value to the City or community-at-large and exceeds \$500.00 in value; and

WHEREAS, Council has considered the request and determined that the property on Exhibit A is no longer of value to the City;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lafayette as follows:

1. That the 2001 Dodge 2500 is hereby declared to be surplus property.
2. That the 2005 Dodge Dakota is hereby declared to be surplus property.
3. That the 1989 Ford Dump Truck is hereby declared to be surplus property.
4. That the City Administrator is authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus property in any manner that is most advantageous to the City or community at-large and that the City Administrator deems appropriate, including but not limited to public auction.

This Resolution shall be and is effective from and after its passage by the Council.
