THE CITY COUNCIL (the “Council”) OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON (the “City”) sat for the transaction of City business on March 14, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall and considered and approved the following Resolution.

WHEREAS, the Downtown Façade Improvement Grant program was established in 2015 to aid 3rd Street building owners in improving their facades to improve their buildings; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2015-14 established a Downtown Design Review and Award Committee to review applications for the grant program; and

WHEREAS, since 2015 only three applications were submitted with one grant expenditure, totaling \$12,500; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that this program has not met the original goals of the program; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the funding for the program may be more effectively utilized elsewhere to meet the program goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Downtown Façade Improvement Grant Program shall be terminated.


This Resolution shall be and is effective from and after its passage by the Council.


