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RESOLUTION NO. 2024-17

THE CITY COUNCIL (the "Council") OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, OREGON (the "City") sat for the transaction of City business on December 12 ,2024, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall and considered and approved the following Resolution.

**WHEREAS**, Lafayette Resolution 2024-17 provides for the disposal of surplus property and defines surplus property as "any personal property of the City that has been determined to be of no use or value to the City"; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Administrator submitted a request to the Council for a declaration that the property described on Exhibit A, attached hereto, is of no further use or value to the City or community-at-large and exceeds \$500.00 in value; and

**WHEREAS**, Council has considered the request and determined that the property on Exhibit A is no longer of value to the City;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Lafayette as follows:


1. That the Whitney Chicago Piano, with a serial number of 28145, Community Center are hereby declared to be surplus property.
2. That the City Administrator is authorized and directed to dispose of the surplus property in any manner that is most advantageous to the City or community-at-large and that the City Administrator deems appropriate, including but not limited to public auction

This Resolution shall be and is effective from and after its passage by the Council.
